Copy of Report by T.P. Tinslay

At about 18.30 hours on 1st November, 1944, a L.R.R. fell in Shardeloes, Road, Deptford, causing heavy casualties and considerable damage to property, 26 houses being completely destroyed. Some 15 Heavy Rescue parties under the direction of Mr. Hurden, Assistant District Officer, were in operation.

At one four-storey house, which had collapsed into the basement, a fire had broken out and during this conflagration Leader Franks made a heroic attempt to rescue two persons trapped and buried under the burning debris. Leader Franks, assisted by Rescueman A.T.W. Sheryer, was working under extremely dangerous conditions in a tunnel formed in debris which was not only on fire but was becoming more unstable as the result of the water from the firemen's hoses. An additional hazard was the probable further collapse of the building as many of the walls
